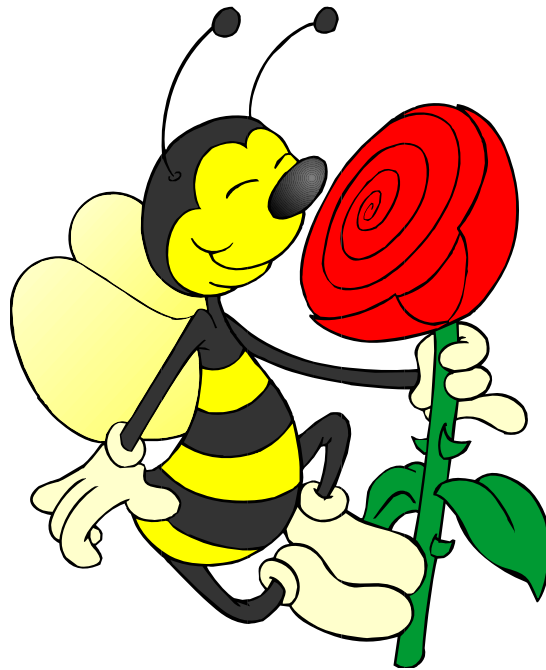

- *Teens Against Tobacco Use (TATU). TATU is designed specifically for teens as a peer-mentoring program. The program is based on research about smoking prevention and the consequences of smoking. Uses a pyramid teaching model with three phases: Adult Facilitator Training, Teen Training, and Youth Presentations. Adult Facilitator trainings are available.*
- *Not On Tobacco (N-O-T). N-O-T is a state of the art voluntary teen smoking cessation program. N-O-T teaches teens how to manage nicotine withdraw and prevent relapse by using a life skills approach. Training is available for N-O-T facilitators.*
- *Freedom From Smoking (FFS). Freedom From Smoking is an eight session behavior modification cessation program that offers participants group support and encouragement. FFS teaches participants to identify personal reasons to stop smoking, learn successful approaches to smoking cessation, identify alternatives to smoking, discover healthy relief of recovery systems and prevent relapse. Trainings are available for smoking cessation facilitators.*
- *Freedom from Smoking Online ([www.lungusa.org](http://www.lungusa.org)). Freedom from Smoking Online is a free, self-paced smoking cessation program that takes users through 7 lessons. Participants have the opportunity to express their cessation joys and concerns on a message board that is shared by hundreds of people, all in the process of quitting smoking.*
- *American Lung Association HelpLine 1-800-LUNG-USA. The American Lung Association offers callers the opportunity to talk with registered nurses or respiratory therapists about a number of lung health issues including stopping smoking, COPD, and lung cancer.*
