

222. SMOKING

1. Purpose The Board recognizes that smoking presents a health hazard which can have serious consequences for both the smoker and the non-smoker and is, therefore, of concern to the Board.
2. Definition For purposes of this policy, "smoking" shall mean all uses of tobacco, including cigar, cigarette, pipe, chewing tobacco and snuff and the school day shall be the time between the first arrival of students and the last departure of students after classes.
- 3.. Authority In order to protect students and staff from the safety hazards of smoking and from an environment noxious to nonsmokers, and because the Board cannot even by indirection, condone the use of tobacco by students, the board prohibits smoking by students in school buildings, on school grounds, on school vehicles owned, or leased or controlled by the School District and during the school day.

4. Delegation of Responsibility The Superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy, which include: informing all students and staff members of the smoking regulations of this district.

A violator of this policy shall be punishable by a civil fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).
